Williams Uniform Complaint Procedures

NOTICE TO PARENTS/GUARDIANS, STUDENTS, AND TEACHERS: COMPLAINT RIGHTS

Parents/Guardians, Students, and Teachers:

Education Code 35186 requires that the following notice be posted in each classroom:

1. There should be sufficient textbooks and instructional materials. For there to be sufficient textbooks and instructional materials, each student, including an English learner, must have access to instructional materials to use at home or after school. This does not require two sets of textbooks or instructional materials.
2. School facilities must be clean, safe, and maintained in good repair. Good repair means that the facility is maintained in a manner that assures that the facility is safe and suitable for use.
3. There should be no teacher vacancies or misassignments as defined in Education Code 35186(h)(2) and (3).

Misassignment means the placement of a certificated employee in a teaching or service position for which the employee does not hold a legally recognized credential.

Teacher vacancy means a position to which a single designated certificated employee has not been assigned at the beginning of the year for an entire year.

4. To file a complaint regarding any of the above matters, complaint forms can be obtained at the principal's office or the district office, or can be downloaded from the district website.
