*We encourage all of you to review the free and reduced lunch application to see if your family qualifies. **It is strictly confidential** and the student's accounts are handled the same whether you pay or they are in the free and reduced lunch program. **Staff, teachers and students** are unaware of who is in the program. **Students in the program will have several places and many choices to select for their daily lunches.***

This year Senate Bill 80 goes into effect (Zero trans fats) and we will be complying with this new regulation. Senate Bill's 12 & 965(Escutia) are still in effect greatly limiting what we can sell on campus. Drinks and snacks as well as a la carte items have strict regulations and the complexion of our snack bar will change the most. In the grab 'n' go area the cost of lunch will be \$3.00 per day and we will be unable to sell a la carte entrees in order to comply with the law. We would be happy to give anyone interested a copy of the regulations.

*We will have a grab and go area, one campus cruiser, our sub sandwich shop and the snack bar area. Seven cashiers will be available for the students to purchase their selections. Each student will have an account. We encourage prepayment on the account. This will speed up the lunch line and better serve your student. Our lines are moving much faster and your student will have plenty of time to get and eat their lunch. **This year we will be instituting EZSchoolPay.com at the High School only, enabling parents to use a credit or debit card to pay for their student's lunches over the internet. We will let you know when this service is available. We will be***

working on making that service available at the elementary schools as well.

*We will offer a full lunch everyday, as well as a few a la carte selections, that meet the new law. There will be several entree selections as well as vegetarian and healthy choices. We will feature fresh fruits and vegetables and well as pizza, burritos and other kid friendly foods. If your student has special dietary needs, we have a form that you can have filled out by your health provider and we can adjust the menu if necessary. The state requires this form to be on file **before we can honor special dietary needs.***
